Effective January 1, 2012

The **Perry County Transfer Station** can no longer accept **e-Waste**



What is e-Waste?

e-Waste is any item that has a **power cord** or is **powered by batteries**.

What prompted this change?

The landfill that accepts all solid waste from Perry County is located in Illinois. Effective January 1st, 2012 **all landfills in Illinois are prohibited by law from accepting e-waste**.

How do I dispose e-Waste?

Where you live determines how you will dispose of e-waste. Please see the map on the reverse side.

Americans discarded 3.5 million tons of e-waste last year.

What should I do with e-Waste?

Options for county residents:

1. Personally deliver e-waste to recycling center
2. Ask your waste hauler if he runs a recycling pick-up


Options for city residents:

1. Personally deliver e-waste to recycling center
2. Put e-waste, except TV's and monitors, in curbside recycling
3. Deliver TV's and monitors to recycling center or use city's bulk trash procedure

Beware Identity Theft!

Before you set a computer curbside on your recycling day, it is highly recommended that you first remove the hard drive or have it swiped to erase personal information. Perry County Recycling is not responsible for electronic items left unattended at curbside.

Old Cell Phones Are Valuable

Discarded cell phones can often be reused. Bag the phone with its manual and accessories before you recycle it.

Fees for Monitors and TV's Reduced for 2012?

To assist citizens with the landfill ban, fees for TV's and monitors have been reduce: monitors \$5; any TV \$20. Please guard against screen breakage as it causes more processing and expense.

City of Perryville Bulk Trash Pick-Up

- Now includes TV's and monitors
- Purchase stickers at city hall (price includes hauling and recycling fees)

Why not recycle everything possible?
