Material	Guidelines
Trash	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The city issues one trash cart at no cost. If you wish a second cart, you shall pay a one-time cost of \$85 and your monthly collection charge will be increased to the commercial rate. Trash shall be placed at the curb, edge of roadway or alley no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day preceding collection and removed on the same day of collection. All items must be at curbside by no later than 7:00 A.M. on the day of scheduled pickup. City-issued trash carts shall be placed in the city street with container wheels against the curb. Customers must allow 3 feet of clearance on each side of the trash cart. Customers must use city-issued trash carts. Exceptions may be requested due to physical disability or extreme terrain by calling Public Works at 547-2500 All trash must be inside of the cart. Trash will not be picked up in bags or lying next to the cart Trash containers must be stored in or near the residence, off the city's right-of-way, and in such a manner that the container shall not become unsightly or a public nuisance DO NOT put liquids (paint, oil, etc.) or electronic waste in any regular trash pickup
Bulk Trash	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bulk trash is defined as furniture, washing machines, stoves, water heaters, or other large appliances found in a residential setting Picked up by request only. Please call 547-2500 no later than 7:00 A.M. on Monday and Friday to schedule pickup for that day. Additional prepaid fees apply for bulk trash pickup: Single Items- \$10; Computer Monitors - \$5; Televisions - \$10
Spring and Fall Cleaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Large volumes of trash less than 60 cubic feet (example: 3'x4'x5' pile) shall be picked up at no additional charge during the third full week of April and the third full week of October each year. Only one pickup per residence allowed in the Spring and in the Fall. This does not include bulk items or electronics Large volumes of trash can be scheduled outside of those times by contacting Public Works at 547-2500 and paying a prepaid fee of \$150 per 360 cubic feet. Homeowner <u>must</u> call to schedule a pickup (547-2500 or 547-2594)
Leaves & Yard Waste Bags	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Vacuum Sweeper</u>: The vacuum sweeper is available for disposing of leaves starting the third full week in October until the last full week before Dec 25 (Christmas). An additional pickup will occur on the second Friday of the month of January, February, and March. Please place leaves next to curb for pickup. Outside of these times, leaves must be bagged and placed at the curb. <u>Bagged</u>: Leaves must be in biodegradable paper bags and placed at curbside. Bags may be purchased at several local retailer locations <u>Small yard waste</u> (e.g. grass, straw, flowers, gum balls, etc.): These items must be in biodegradable paper bags and placed at curbside. The weight of the container and contents shall not exceed 50 pounds Please DO NOT mix other trash items with leaves or yard waste
Limbs & Large Yard Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Property owners or occupiers may provide for the cleanup and maintenance of their property by cutting tree limbs, brush, vegetation, and other related items. The city will provide for removal of these items; however, this service shall be for normal cleanup, maintenance and removal and shall not apply to lot clearing, site preparation for development, utility right-of-way maintenance, or other major projects. Limbs and large yard/garden waste (e.g. flower/garden stalks, twigs, shrubbery, etc) must be stacked loosely at curbside; do not tie materials together Materials may be placed in some type of heavy storage container at the curbside that will not be removed from the property. The weight of the container and contents shall not exceed 50 pounds. Do not put this material in paper bags, boxes, or any lightweight containers Limbs must be no larger than 4" in diameter; the City will chip at curbside or pickup at its discretion No stumps, logs, or root wads will be collected
Recycling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Curbside recycling is no longer offered at this time Your recyclable items may be taken to the Perry County Recycling Center which is located at 5232 N. Highway 51 Call 547-5006 for information regarding drop-off hours and types of items allowed
Collection Site	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The City may in its absolute discretion provide trash pick-up on or along private drives provided that the private drive is constructed in a manner that provides for the safe operation of City equipment and the safety of City workers. In addition, the owner of the private drive must agree that any damage to the drive or surrounding property will not be the responsibility of the City. The customer and the owner of the private drive acknowledge that trash trucks are heavy and that they will damage structures that are not designed to carry the weight of a trash truck. The City reserves the absolute right to discontinue trash service on the private drive for any reason. To sign up for trash pickup on a private drive, contact the Utility Billing Department at 547-2594.
